Ngununggula is dedicated to nurturing creativity and enjoyment of the arts for all ages and abilities. We are pleased to announce Ngununggula's inaugural student art prize for local students K-12. To coincide with our exhibition New Dog Old Tricks the theme for 2023 is pet portraits!

Entry Criteria

- Each school in the Southern Highlands region is invited to enter up to 10 artworks.
- Artworks must be original and capture the spirit of an animal companion.
- Artworks must be two-dimensional (e.g. drawing, painting, printmaking, digital) and be completed on paper
- The 5-8 and 9-12 years categories artwork dimension is A4
- The 13-15 and 16-18 years categories artwork dimension is A3
- Any art material or combination of materials may be used.
- Works must be unframed and unmounted

Entries close: 1 September 2023 (submission via email)

Shortlisted candidates notified: Early September

Artworks delivered to Ngununggula: 15 September

Opening event + announcement of winners: Sunday 19 November

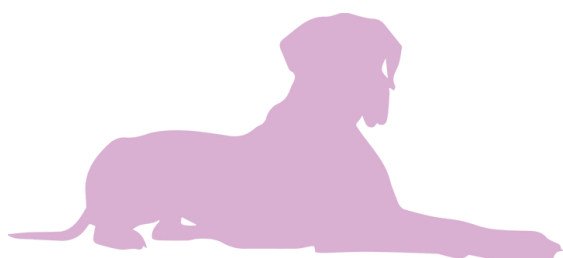
